Southern Arizona's Monsoon Your Summer Storm Guide

Summer in Marana isn't just about sunshine, sunsets, and swimming pools. We're treated to another show of light and water: The Monsoon. Brilliant lightning streaks across the sky, thunder rattles the ground, and the rain arrives, bringing life and nourishment to the desert. For residents and new neighbors, understanding the monsoon is key to staying safe and enjoying its dramatic beauty.

The Monsoon officially starts on **June 15th**, running through **September 30th**. Every summer, residents of Southern Arizona wait for its arrival with anticipation. If significant rain falls, the Monsoon transforms the desert environment into a lush paradise.

The Monsoon is most active in **July and early August**. The six mountain ranges that surround Marana provide just the backdrop that photographers and observers are looking for. Scan the QR code to find the best places to catch lightning in Marana!

Safety is the top priority when in a Monsoon.

Even long-time residents sometimes underestimate the power of desert storms, and it's especially important to understand if you're new to the region.

Where To Catch Lightning in Marana



SAFETY TIPS:

- **Be prepared** – check the weather forecast and plan accordingly.
- Pull over if you're caught in heavy rain or a dust storm.
- **Avoid washes** and rivers during heavy rains.
- Never drive through flowing water. *Turn around, don't drown.*
- Never drive through or around barriers.
- Watch lightning storms from an enclosed structure or a car.
- Protect your home.
- Safeguard your environment.
- Check Maranaaz.gov for potential sandbag stations
